Cadmium Red Medium

I will be using this brand of brushes and paints (Hobby Lobby)

Bob Ross Brand brushes: 1/2” floral Bright, #12 Floral Filbert, Floral Round, 1” landscape brush

- 12x16 stretched canvas will be used unless otherwise stated in classroom
- ODORLESS TUPERNOID blue and white label thinner. Tupertine will not be allowed inside of the classroom
- Container or Jar to hold your thinner
- Bob Ross Oil painting medium or make your own (½ linseed oil + ½ odorless thinner)
- small container to hold your medium
- paper towels
- black and white graphite or transfer paper
- pencil and note pad
- 1” wide masking tape
- **Palette paper for oil painting**

I will be teaching and working with Bob Ross brand oil paints and brushes most of the time.
